






Arts Education



WHEREAS, arts education, including dance, media arts, music, theatre arts, and visual arts is an essential element of a complete and well rounded education for all students; and


- WHEREAS, arts education enables all students to develop critical thinking and problem solving, imagination and creativity, discipline and collaboration, alternative ways to communicate and express feelings and ideas, and cross-cultural understanding, which support personalized pathways to academic success across the curriculum; and
- WHEREAS, arts education contributes to increased attendance and graduation rates; elevates academic achievement; and prepares students for college, career, and citizenship readiness; and


